



### **Nurse Aide Phase 1 or 75 hour Nurse Aide Student Health Requirements**

#### **A. Student Health Requirements.**

1. Required immunizations:
  - a. Measles (Rubeola) – 2 vaccination dates required or a positive serology.  
Mumps – 2 vaccination dates required, or a positive serology.  
Rubella – 1 vaccination date required or a positive serology.
  - b. Tetanus – 1 one-time dose of Tdap vaccine or a Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis booster is recommended every 10 years.
  - c. Chickenpox – 2 doses of Varicella vaccine is recommended for those who do not have a history of Chickenpox.
  - d. Chickenpox/Varicella screen/serology if no vaccine has been administered.
  - e. Hepatitis B vaccine series.
  - f. Annual Influenza.
2. All students will be in compliance with State regulations for communicable disease tests and vaccinations. Included on the list is TB (Mantoux), Tetanus toxoid (Tdap) and MMR. Any student with a positive reaction to the Mantoux test shall have a chest x-ray taken. It is the responsibility of the student to schedule and receive the Mantoux test and x-ray as recommended by your healthcare provider. The student is responsible for the cost of the Mantoux test and x-ray if required. The student is responsible for the cost of all immunizations.
3. The College shall maintain records showing that students have received the required vaccines or have a positive serology. The student is responsible for the cost of the vaccine(s) and/or applicable serology testing.
4. Documentation of immunizations and two step TB, etc. must be turned into the health coordinator before a pre-determined deadline date for your specific class.
