



Nurse Aide Computer Based Competency Exam Marshalltown Schedule 2019

Nurse Aide (NA) Computer Based Competency Exam

1. This is a computer based exam with 100 multiple choice questions.
2. You are given a maximum of 2 hours to take the exam.
3. You must receive 70% or above to pass the exam.
4. Your pass or fail score is automatically sent to the Iowa Direct Care Workers' (DCW) Registry.
5. You can access your information on the DCW web site at <https://dia.iowa.gov/health-facilities/certified-nursing-assistants>.
6. You should arrive for your exam at least 15 minutes prior to the start time.
7. You must bring photo ID with you.
8. You must cancel at least 3 business days prior to your exam time in order to receive a refund.
9. Exam date changes will be accommodated and payments transferred to the new test date if this is done at least 3 business days prior to your original scheduled exam date.
10. There are **NO Refunds** for no call no show exam candidates.
11. You can test up to 3 times. You will need to register and pay for each exam.
12. If you fail the exam 3 times you are required to register, pay and attend another nurse aide class.
13. Exams begin at 2:30 pm. and will conclude by 4:30 pm.
14. No Cell phones or any electronic devices are allowed in the exam area.

Nurse Aide (NA) Computer Based Oral Competency Exam

1. The computer based exam is read to the testing candidate and the candidate chooses their answer by clicking on their choice.
2. All of the above information applies to the Oral Competency Exam.
3. Exams begin at 9:00 am or 11:00 am
4. Students should check in with the Iowa Valley Continuing Education receptionist and wait in the lobby area. The test proctor will notify you when your test is ready.

Cost: \$55

Location for the computer based competency exam: Marshalltown Community College, **Business and Technology Center, room 201** located at 3700 S Center St Marshalltown. Take exit 185 off of highway 30 then go south. Turn into the Marshalltown Community College entrance, this will wind around towards the back of campus. Before you get to the dorms you will see the Business and Technology Center. There is parking near this building. Enter the main door and then enter the computer lab room 201. The Business and Technology Center is located on the far northeast corner of the campus and is east of the main MCC building.

Location for the computer based oral competency exam: Iowa Valley Continuing Education, 3702 S Center St., Marshalltown, room 805. Take exit 185 off of highway 30 then go south. Keep going south past the MCC entrance. You will see the baseball field and an entrance into the campus. Turn into this entrance, go a short distance and you will see a big parking lot to your left, turn into this parking lot. You will see a flag pole, door #11, and outside on the building it says Continuing Education. Enter door #11 and you will be in the lobby area. Check in with the receptionist and wait in the lobby for the testing proctor.

Additional Information: Up to 15 people can enroll for a two hour computer exam session. Exam dates are closed 3 business days prior to the exam. Oral Competency Exam is one on one and a specific exam time is designated at the time of registration.
