### Nurse Aide (NA) Skills Competency Exam

1. The skills exam is designed as a realistic NA caregiving assignment.
2. There will be 7 skills taken from the list of 30 skills you learned in your class.
3. There will be handwashing and communication plus other skills.
4. You are given a maximum of 45 minutes to complete the exam.
5. Points are assigned for each skill performed.
6. You must receive 70% or above to pass.
7. Your pass or fail score is sent to the Iowa Direct Care Workers' (DCW) Registry.
8. You can access your information on the DCW web site at <https://dia.iowa.gov/health-facilities/certified-nursing-assistants>.
9. You should arrive for your exam at least 15 minutes prior to the start time.
10. You must bring photo ID with you.
11. You must cancel at least 3 business days prior to your exam time in order to receive a refund.
12. Exam date changes will be accommodated and payments transferred to the new test date if this is done at least 3 business days prior to your original scheduled exam date.
13. There are **NO Refunds** for no call no show exam candidates.
14. It is recommended that you wear your clinical uniform.
15. You will need a watch with second hand.
16. You can test up to a total of three times. You will need to register and pay for each exam.
17. If you fail the exam 3 times you are required to register, pay and attend another nurse aide class.
18. Exams are given during the day and evenings. You will be assigned a specific exam time at the time you register for the exam. Skills exams are performed with one student, one test proctor and a patient.
19. Exam dates are closed 3 business days prior to the exam.
20. No Cell phones or any electronic devices are allowed in the skills exam area.

**Cost: \$95**

**Location for the skills competency exam:** Iowa Valley Continuing Education, 3702 S Center St., Marshalltown, room 622. Take exit 185 off of highway 30 then go south. Keep going south past the MCC entrance. You will see the baseball field and an entrance into the campus. Turn into this entrance, go a short distance and you will see a big parking lot to your left, turn into this parking lot. You will see a flag pole, door #11, and outside on the building it says Continuing Education. Enter door #11 and you will be in the lobby area. Go to your right down the hallway to room 622. Be seated in the lounge area across from room 622 and the skills exam proctor will notify you when your exam is ready.
