The Accounting curriculum prepares the student for employment as an accountant in government, industry and private accounting enterprises. Students who complete this accounting program may expect to enter the job market as payroll accountants, accounts payable and accounts receivable clerks, general bookkeepers or in other private accounting positions. Demand for accountants is stronger than the supply, so students seeking positions with an AAS degree also have good job prospects.
