Please submit the original supporting documents with this financial statement to Ellsworth Community College.

Students transferring from another U.S college

You will need to submit supporting documents. Additional supporting documents may be requested.

Important Note

Under U.S. Immigration Law, international students are not allowed to work off campus during their first year in the U.S. ECC does not guarantee on-campus employment for international students. After the first year, international students can secure part-time work only if they apply to Immigration for permission. Permission to work part-time is granted only in hardship cases where there has been a distinct change of financial circumstances beyond the control of the student.
