



CEP Adjunct Application Checklist

High school instructors seeking approval to teach CEP courses must meet the qualifications and complete the following steps:

Teacher Qualifications: Arts & Science = Master's degree with a minimum of 18 graduate credit hours in the subject area taught
Career & Technical = 3 years experience and/or 6,000 hours

Application Steps:

- Submit an online application at https://forms.iavalley.edu/district/forms/affirmative_action.php.
- Submit transcript(s) and/or resume:
 - To teach Arts & Science courses, submit official college transcripts.
 - To teach Career & Technical courses, submit a resume to document three years and/or 6,000 hours work experience in the field.

Once all materials have been reviewed, applicants will be contacted with approval or denial of the CEP Adjunct position request. New CEP Adjuncts will be assigned a Faculty Liaison and will attend an on-campus orientation. The training session will involve a CEP overview and planning time with the Faculty Liaison to discuss the syllabus and course content. The orientation will also provide information for submitting student grades and other college policies.

A course syllabus must be submitted annually to the NACEP Coordinator (a template will be provided by your Faculty Liaison).

Throughout the year you'll maintain contact with your Faculty Liaison. He/she will complete a site visit and a course checkpoint, and work with you to develop and use the shared assessment for your course(s). The NACEP Coordinator will offer ongoing professional development opportunities to support you as a CEP Adjunct faculty member.
