

## Employee reports to supervisor or HR:

The employee should start their 10 Day quarantine or isolation immediately (do not come to campus). HR is notified immediately.

Confirmed positive exposure

Experiencing symptoms of COVID-19

Tested positive to COVID-19

The employee will stay home as soon as symptoms begin or they are aware of a confirmed positive exposure. Contact supervisor and HR. HR will confirm quarantine dates with employee and supervisor.

- **Isolate for 10 days** since symptoms first appeared **and**
- 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications **and**
- Other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving

**Quarantine can end after Day 10** if no symptoms have been reported during daily monitoring:

- Testing is not required
- Continue to monitor for symptoms until the end of the 14 days but can return to work
- Masks are required at all times, social distance, and wash hands frequently until the end of the 14 days. May remove mask for eating and drinking.
- **Quarantine can end after Day 7** if no symptoms have been reported during daily monitoring **AND** if you have tested negative for COVID-19
- The COVID-19 test must be collected on Day 5 or later after the exposure
- Continue to monitor for symptoms until the end of the 14 days
- Masks are required at all times, social distance, and wash hands frequently until the end of the 14 days. May remove mask for eating and drinking.
