Important Note

Under U.S. Immigration Law, international students are not allowed to work off campus during their first year in the U.S. MCC does not guarantee on-campus employment for international students. After the first year, international students can secure part-time off-campus work only if they apply to

Immigration for permission. Permission to work part-time is granted only in hardship cases where there has been a distinct change of financial circumstances beyond the control of the student.
