PawPass: Your Online Student Portal



This guide will walk you through logging in to PawPass, the student portal for lowa Valley Community College District.

Before you begin:

- Find the email you received from ITSecurity@iavalley.edu with your login information. This email is sent to the email address you indicated on your admissions application.
- If you haven't received the email, check your spam folder or search for emails with the subject line " Your ECC/MCC Email Account Information."

What you'll need:

- Your lowa Valley email address (format: First.Last@iavalley.edu)
- Your randomly generated password (provided in the email, for example: A76751D7-150)
- A smartphone with the ability to install the Microsoft Authenticator app.

Steps to Log In:

- 1. Open a web browser. (e.g., Chrome, Firefox, Safari)
- 2. Go to the PawPass login page: https://pawpass.iavalley.edu/
- 3. Click the Login button at the top right corner of the page and follow the sign-in prompts, using your lowa Valley email address and password you received from ITSecurity.
- 4. You will be prompted to change your password. Your password must be at least sixteen (16) characters long and must include: one (1) uppercase, one (1) lowercase, and one (1) digit. Symbols are *not* required.

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA):

MFA adds an extra layer of security by requiring a verification code in addition to your password.

- The Microsoft Authenticator app is required for MFA.
- Upon first login, you will be prompted to set up Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA).
