All health certificates must be current (within 30 days of the event), must specify the physical address of the event center: 709 Ellsworth Avenue, Iowa Falls, IA 50126, and shall only be used for one exhibition.

For the convenience of our exhibitors, we will have a veterinarian on-site from 5pm-7pm on the Friday before our Open Shows who will inspect incoming equines for a discounted rate of \$5.00 per animal. Those attending our event who cannot acquire a health certificate during this time must provide a current health certificate from an alternate source at the time of registration. Any animals who are being transported across state lines will not be eligible for inspection at Ellsworth Equestrian Center as they are required to have a current health certificate AND Coggins test prior to attending the event.

Any equine or exhibitor found to be in violation of these requirements will be asked to leave the event immediately. SERVICE ANIMALS ONLY **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS**

Per Board Policy 526 (Service & Assistance Animal Policy): IVCCD prohibits the presence of animals on its campuses, with the exception of those animals used for academic purposes (e.g., laboratory and instructional use), service animals, and assistance animals (campus housing only).

As such, dogs or other animals not being exhibited at the event who are not service animals will **not be permitted on the grounds of, or in any building of the Equestrian Center** during shows, exhibitions, sales, or any other events in our facility. Any person found to be in violation of this policy will be asked to remove the animal from the facility immediately.

Saturday & Sunday Entry Fees: \$5 per class, \$50.00 all-day rate per horse; \$40 for ECC students. Does not include Jackpot fees.

ALL JACKPOT class entries cost <u>an additional</u> \$5 per class

- Stallions must be shown only by adults aged 18 and over.
- There shall be no tying-out (to trailers) or corralling of equines overnight.
- There shall be no tying of equines in the wash rack except when bathing/hosing.
- ➤ Limit of 1 horse/pony per stall.

Horse Stalls:

\$61 per stall, includes 2 bags of shavings.

***Additional shavings may be purchased for
\$8.00 per bag – please make requests for
additional bedding when reserving stalls.

- ***ALL additional shavings must be purchased from the event center.
- ***No outside bedding permitted***

Tack Stalls: \$45 per stall

Jump-outs: \$30 per horse, per day

Electrical hook-ups: \$25 per night (24 hookups)

NO SMOKING, TOBACCO USE OR ALCOHOL is permitted on the Hamilton Campus grounds or in Ellsworth Equestrian Center.
