Full deposit or credit card # required to reserve stalls. Reservations must be cancelled <u>7 days in advance of the</u> event to receive a refund.

A signed check payable to Ellsworth Equestrian Center must be left with the show office before entries are made to classes.

Classes are \$5.00 each.

Jackpot classes are an additional \$5.00.

Additional shavings may be purchased for \$8.00 per bag.

ALL additional shavings must be purchased from the event center.

There will be a \$35.00 per stall fee attached to any stalls that use outside bedding.

There shall be no tying-out (to trailers) or corralling of horses overnight, and no tying of horses in the wash rack except when bathing/hosing. Limit of 1 horse/pony per stall.

Stallions must be shown only by adults. Jump-outs will only be allowed if all the stalls are full. Jump-outs are \$30 per horse.

NO SMOKING, TOBACCO USE OR ALCOHOL is permitted at the Ellsworth Equestrian Center.

Ellsworth Equestrian Center is not responsible for accidents, theft or lost items.

## **DOG POLICY**

- Leash Requirement: In accordance with the City
  of Iowa Falls Code of Ordinances, all dogs on
  the Hamilton Campus of Ellsworth Community
  College must be restrained at all times. This can
  be done with a leash/tether, closed doors,
  gates, pens, or crates.
- Pet Owner Responsibility: Pet owners are expected to use good judgment when allowing pets in public spectator areas. Pets must also be leashed when entering or exiting the building and in common areas.

- Clean-up: Owners are required to clean up after their dogs immediately. Waste should be properly disposed of in waste bins or manure bins.
- 4. Noise and Behavior: Dogs must be quiet and well-behaved. They cannot run at large, even under voice command. Uncontrolled or unruly behavior may result in the owner being asked to leave the premises.
- 5. Identification: Dogs must wear their current license and rabies tags at all times.
- 6. Service Animals: Any individual who requires the use of a service animal is welcome to contact the Equine Facilities and Events Coordinator prior to the event, or upon their arrival at the event center, to fill out a brief form that includes their contact information in case of emergency. This acknowledges that they will keep their service animal leashed/under control during their time in the facility.
- 7. Penalties for Violations: Violations of city ordinances regarding dog control will result in fines, as outlined in Section 55.8. Repeat offenses may lead to impoundment or removal of the dog.
- 8. Liability: Dog owners assume full liability for any injuries, damages, or incidents caused by their dogs. The Equestrian Center will not be held responsible for any dog-related incidents.
- 9. Discretion of Management: Equestrian Center management reserves the right to ask any individual to remove their dog from the premises if they are not adhering to the dog policy or causing disturbances. Individuals who repeatedly violate the rules will face restrictions on bringing dogs to the facility, potentially incurring fines for the group renting the facility or jeopardizing the renters' ability to use the facility in the future.

By bringing your dog to the Equestrian Center, you acknowledge and agree to abide by this policy. Failure to comply may result in restricted access or being asked to leave the premises. Your cooperation ensures a safe and enjoyable environment for all visitors, riders, and animals at the Equestrian Center.
