

# College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

## Overview

CLEP tests allow students to earn college credit by demonstrating knowledge through exams. This can reduce time to degree completion, lighten course loads, and save money.

## Important Information

Students should confirm with their intended college whether CLEP credits are accepted and what score requirements apply. Policies vary by institution.

A minimum score of 50 is generally required for credit at MCC/ECC. Not all CLEP exams are accepted.

## Registration and Testing

Students must create an account on the CLEP website, purchase an exam, and schedule testing through MCC or ECC.

On test day, students must bring a CLEP registration ticket and a valid government-issued photo ID.

## Fees

CLEP exam fee is \$97 and is paid directly to CLEP.

Test administration fee is \$40 and is paid to the testing location.

## **Credit Limits**

A maximum of 30 CLEP credit hours may be applied toward an Associate of Arts degree.
