He noted this is an opportunity to get together to reacquaint the three community colleges and Central Rivers AEA and to learn more about each other. Dr. Schulz also shared academic highlights, construction project updates, upcoming personnel changes, planned upgrades, anticipated new programs, and potential challenges for the year ahead.

Introductions:

Dr. Todd Holcomb introduced board members in attendance including Board Chair Jay Nardini, Directors Louis Beck, Barbara McGregor, and Dave Westley. Also in attendance was Board Secretary & Assistant to the President Dee Paulsen.

<u>Updates:</u>

Dr. Todd Holcomb shared that the Automation and Robotics Center's open house was last fall. Dr. Holcomb gave a review on facility construction projects. Students were back in class on January 8th in Grundy Hall and the Open House will be on April 18th. Grundy Hall now has the capacity to serve 3,300 students, has an expanded state of the art dental clinic and expanded simulation center. He also shared the Regional Transportation and Training Center will be remodeled and receive three additions. The estimated cost for the project is \$5,388,000 and will be finished by December 31, 2024. Dr. Holcomb also gave an update on achievements, awards and recognitions Hawkeve Community College received over the last year including national accolades for student Danny Dillon, 2023 Best Place for Working Parents, Exemplary Program Award for WE Build Waterloo, 2024 Educator of the Year: Gerrot Jacobson, finalist for Golden Owl Award: Amber Greiman and successful RISC survey completion. Hawkeye Community College also received grants for PEER and SMART Iowa initiatives, was the recipient of Strengthening Community Colleges Training Grant and others, hosted the 2023 Women's leadership & empowerment conference and 2023 manufacturing conference. Dr. Holcomb reported the college hired a Men's & Women Wrestling coach, won the ACUI National championship in Sports Shooting and the introduction of the new softball program last year is off to a great start with 22 student athletes.
