



IVCCD Emergency Notification System

The IVCCD Emergency Notification System (ENS) alerts students, faculty and staff in the event of a weather or critical incident emergency. The contact information students provide on the Application for Admission form will be used in the event of an emergency that impacts the health and safety of the College community or closures of campuses.

Emergency messages will be sent to the cell phone number provided on the Application for Admission, as well as to student email addresses (...@iavalley.edu).

Automatically Enrolled

All students are automatically enrolled in the IVCCD Emergency Notification System.

Changes

Changes to phone numbers must be communicated to the College. Students should submit a Personal Information Change Form to the Registrar's Office as soon as possible to ensure continued receipt of ENS messages.

Opt Out

Individuals may elect to opt out of receiving text messages from the IVCCD Emergency Notification System by texting "stop alert" to 23177. Students cannot opt out of receiving ENS messages to student email accounts.

Opt In Later

Those who opt out and want to opt in later can text "subscribe alert" to 23177.

Students enrolled in ENS prior to Fall 2017

Student phone numbers in the ENS system are purged annually. Current students are re-enrolled in ENS each fall using the cell phone information provided on the Application for Admission form and student email address.

Emergency messages are customized to student/staff groups at the respective campuses. Students only receive emergency messages from the College campus at which they're enrolled.
