



## **2026 Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA) – Four-Year Average Graduation and Transfer Rates Report**

### **Ellsworth and Marshalltown Community Colleges**

Under the federal Student Right-to-Know legislation, colleges are mandated to furnish graduation and transfer rate details for students who received athletically related student aid. This report presents such information for the four- year average IPEDS first-time, full-time, degree-seeking Fall 2019 – FA2022 cohorts.
