- T Th classes include T, Th, TTh, ThF, TThF, MTW, MTTh, MTThF, MWTh, MTh
- Classes which begin at times other than on the hours (i.e. 9:30) will take the final exam at the time scheduled for the next hour (i.e. 10:00).
- Students with more than three exams on one day may make arrangements with the instructor(s) to take exams beyond three on another day. When common exams are involved, they should be taken as scheduled.
- Any change in time of a final examination must be recommended in writing by the instructor and approved by the Dean of Instruction.
- Evening classes will take finals during the final's week during regular class times.
- Hybrid/stacked course final exams will be determined by the instructor. The instructor will likely meet during the first time period of the normal week, but students will have to review for conflicts.

In case of a weather event during Finals week, any exams called off by delays or cancelled school will move to the next day at the same location and times. For example, if a full day is cancelled, all finals for the rest of the week will be moved one day forward into the future. If the college has a delayed start, all finals up until the college start time will move one day forward for the rest of the week. Please review Canvas for updates in these scenarios.
